I was really pleased to note the excellent temperament for all the dogs I judged. Overall, I felt the dogs had good heads and expressions, but movement and construction was a bit more hit and miss. There were also some absolutely stunning bitches put in front of me and a couple of youngsters I will certainly watch with interest.

Class 1 MPD – No entries

Class 3 JD 4/1

1st Lownsbrough's – Vickvally's the right track to Sonhador – Promising youngster, well marked, square muzzle, good bite, well placed dark eyes and ears of good size and shape, all giving a wonderful expression, good neck into correct shoulder, straight front, tidy feet, good spring of rib, short coupled, correct topline & tail set, good turn of stifle, short strong hocks, moved well both ways, won the class on overall compactness and finish.

2nd – Wildman's – Wildax Gideon Jones – Another promising youngster, taller in type, with head and expression equal to 1st, good neck into well placed shoulder & front, good spring of rib correct topline, has good rear angles but tends to over extend his rear when stood, it all comes together on the move so just needs time to tighten and bring it altogether.

Class 4 MD – No entries.

Class 6 PGD 3/1

1st Fearn's – Ringablok Diamond gent at Ledzepp – Well marked, 18 months old youngster, square & compact and full of breed type, outstanding head and expression, square muzzle, well placed dark eyes, ears small and perfectly placed, good neck into sloping shoulder, straightest of fronts with good bone for his size and tight neat feet, good spring of rib & topline, short coupled, moved well both ways, standing square when allowed to stand on his own. Pleased to award him best dog for his superb head qualities and spot on front. BD & BOS.

2nd – Pellowe's – Wenfryn Mr Twister – Well marked, taller and rangy in type, dark eyes, good bite, good length of neck well placed shoulder, straight front, good spring of rib, longer cast than 1st, good tail set and rear angles, moved well both ways.

Class 7 LD 7/4

1st – Rostron-Parker's – Rosparquier Quint major – Well marked brindle, upstanding larger type, square muzzle, well placed eyes and ears with a good bite, good arched neck into well laid shoulder, straight front, good topline & tail set, correct rear angles, one of the best movers on the day.

2nd – Cradock's – Esangee star surprise for Nelinnie – well marked, smaller and compact type, well placed dark eyes and ears carried well, good square muzzle, good neck into sloping shoulder, straight front, well sprung rib, rear angles not as strong as 1st movement good in front could do with more drive from rear.

Class 8 OD 4/1

1st - Hamilton's - CH Havasu sand storm – Well marked brindle, medium sized, compact and well balanced throughout, good muzzle, dark well placed eyes and ears of good size carried well, good neck into correct shoulder, straight front, good feet, well sprung rib, correct topline & tail set, good rear angles, moved well both ways, a class act and pushed hard for best dog. RBD.

2nd – Stoner's – Eairycor Celtic warrior – Well marked, finer in bone than 1st, square and compact, square muzzle, dark well placed eyes, ears well placed, straight front, correct shoulder, good spring of rib, correct topline & tail set good rear angles.

Class 11 MPB 3/3

Class 12 PB 2/0

1st – Mathias-Lowe's – Mathio Queen bee – Small perfectly balanced & elegant, well marked brindle, feminine expression with square muzzle, well placed dark eyes and ears of correct size & set, good neck into correct shoulder, straight front, tight feet, ribs well sprung, correct topline & tail set and good rear angles, needs to learn to settle on the move, but from the brief glimpses I got when she settled, it looked good. One to watch! BPB & BPIS.

2nd – Bastow & Hodkinson's – Abadgero Luc at Sybilla for Beaconfell – Another cracking bitch puppy, Brindle, lager type than 1st, square muzzle, correct eye and ear placement, good neck into correct shoulder, straight front, good feet, good

spring of rib correct topline, good rear angles, being a bigger girl she will need time to mature but a lovely puppy.

Class 13 JB 4/2

1st – Schfaild’s – Vickvally’s my dear heart – Well marked dark brindle, beautifully balanced, compact & strongly built, feminine girl, square muzzle, good bite, dark well placed eyes, ears of good size and correctly placed, good reach of neck into correct shoulder, straight front, well sprung ribs, correct topline & tail set, short coupled, good turn of stifle with well muscled quarters, moved well both ways, a stunning youngster and another with a bright future. RBB & RBIS.

2nd – Hartley & Fahey’s – Zoomera Jubilee rox – Well marked, taller type than 1st, adequate strength of muzzle, dark well placed eyes and ears well set, good reach of neck, straight front, and good rear angles, erratic on the move.

Class 14 MB No entries.

Class 15 NB 1/0

1st – Bastow & Hodkinson’s – Beaconfell that’ll do nicely – Nicely proportioned taller elegant type, good bite, well placed dark eyes, ears of good size set well, good neck into correct shoulder, good spring of rib, correct topline & tail set, good rear angles, moved ok with drive from behind.

Class 16 PGB – 4/1

1st – Mathias-Lowe’s – Donmar Flirty flora at Mathio – Well marked, nicely proportioned of medium size, square muzzle, dark well placed eyes with ears right on top, giving a wonderful feminine expression, good neck into correct shoulder, straight front, tidy feet, good spring of rib, correct topline & tail set, good rear angles moved well both ways.

2nd - Rostron-Parker’s – Rosparquier Royal flush – Another well marked quality bitch, square muzzle, good bite, well placed dark eyes, small well placed ears, good neck into correct shoulder, straight front, correct topline and tailset, slightly longer than 1st, moved well both ways.

Class 17 LB – 6/3

1st - Corrin’s – Eairycor Celtic princess – beautiful balance and proportions to this medium sized well marked bitch, feminine expression, square muzzle, good bite, dark eyes and small ears exactly where they should be, good clean neck into correct shoulder, straight front with just the right amount of bone, tidy feet, correct topline & tail set, short coupled with good bend of stifle and short strong hocks, moved with style and grace, a stunner. Pleased to award her BB & BIS.

2nd – Schfaild’s – Vickvally Ellary’s beauty – well marked, strongly built, slightly larger than 1st, square muzzle, well placed dark eyes, ears of good size set a little

wide and not quite the expression of 1, good reach of neck, good shoulder, straight front, correct topline and tail set, moved well.

Class 18 OB – 5/2

1st - Metcalfe's - Jayrock Angels delight - medium sized, well marked, with lovely balance throughout, feminine expression, square muzzle, well set dark eyes, well placed ears, good neck into correct shoulder, straight front, neat feet, good spring of rib correct topline & tail set, good rear angles, moved well both ways but not with the same purpose as my top winners today.

2nd – Lownsbrough's – Sonhador Truly scrumptious – Compact, medium sized, well marked but with a slightly darker muzzle, well placed dark eyes, ears of good size, good neck into sloping shoulder, straight front, tidy feet, good spring of rib, correct topline & tail set, good rear angles, moved true but would prefer to see a little more get up & go.
